Why Kramerius and digitization itself?



- first impetus:
 - huge floods in 2002
 - large number of documents damaged
- endagering of documents by the degradation of acid paper
- reformating used as the method of replacement
- need to create special tool that would make these copies accessible and arrange a funding mechanism



Kramerius established!!!



Ministry of Culture Funding Mechanism?



- subprogramme of the Public Information Services in Libraries funding mechanism
- since 2002
- every public library is allowed to ask for money
 - within 10 years more than 40 institutions ask for money
- last years approximately 750 000 pages digitized yearly
 - all proposed projects are verified against Digitization Registry
 - none unwanted duplicities
- compulsory standardization enables migrations, replications etc.



Digital Library Development?



- development under the cooperation:
 - National Library of Czech Republic
 - Moravian Library Brno
 - Academy of Sciences Library
 - private companies Qbizm and Incad
- funding:
 - institutional budgets
 - national research projects
 - support from Ministry of Culture



Digital Library Usability?



- more than 30 libraries use this system
- open source solution
- connection to other library systems Aleph,
 Digitization Registry
- strong solution largest instalation has over milions pages
- huge user group
 - sharing experience
 - enables data replication
 - best practices in various types of libraries



K5 PRECONDITIONS

- K5 user interface will be separated from admin interface
- K5 New functional API
- Current UI will be used for administration
- K5 UI will be designed mobile devices
- UI of CDL and K5 will be the same/almost the same




"Maximum of the screen space for document"
